"I like doing lemonade stands, and I just feel like... happiness," Paige said. The duo started Easy Peasy Lemon Squeezy Lemonade Stand in August 2020, when they began to deal with depression from being stuck in their home. Jones, who was volunteering at a Robeson County school, had also lost her job during those months.

Tipton says they built the business on their property and got to work. "In the midst of all of that, we tried to find something to do."

Paige is also on the spectrum. When she was a baby, she contracted spinal meningitis which led to extensive brain damage. Doctors told Tipton that Paige would only live 11 years. NOW JONES IS 32 Years old.

"I'm an inspiring young lady," Paige told Eyewitness News. Both women say this business is about being inclusive and showing, no matter who doubts you or the challenges, people with special needs can be productive members of society.

"This is what a perfect world looks like to us, it's the inclusion," Tipton said. At some point, Paige would like to return to the classroom and teach art, but until then, she and Tipton will run this business as partners and look to hire on other people who are on the spectrum. Paige is also part of our Day Supports in our Lumberton Location.
